- Avoid walking around with your device as you participate in the training! If your video feature is on, you are taking us with you - this can be very distracting.
- Join the training from a quiet space. You may be muted by the trainer to eliminate background noise.
- Use the "Chat" feature if you have a question specific to your classroom/home settings and we can arrange a time to talk in more details afterwards. As the training event is just one hour, there will not be much time to address individual concerns during the event.
- Be an active participant! Come ready to share your thoughts with others. Our trainers love learning from their participants.
- Plan to learn and have fun!
